

## Jesus – The Hope of All Nations

### Isaiah 11:1-10

#### A. Context: Sin, Death, and Destruction

1. Israel's \_\_\_\_\_ had prompted the LORD's wrath by repeatedly \_\_\_\_\_ against His authority and faithful love. In response, the LORD pronounced \_\_\_\_\_ upon judgment for His people to endure at the hands of Assyria. (Isaiah 1-9)
